On February 11, 2010, University of Civil Engineering Bucharest with the support of CFPPDA Foundation will organize at the Faculty of Hydrotechnics, Bv Lacul Tei 124, Bucharest – 2nd district, a working meeting on the project Wacom: Wacom Workshop „**WAtter CCompetences Model Transfer**”.

In short, the objectives of this project are:

definition of a European competence model (Wacom) for the management of the water resources by applying the EQF (European Qualification Directive) and the German competent model (STEP 1093)

application of the Wacom component model in the wastewater treatment plants

pilot testing of the WACOM model for the management of the wastewater treatment plants by Water Academy of the German Association DWA

further evaluation of the Wacom modelin other three partner countries (Greece, Romania, Hungary) and its optimization

transfer of the WACOM model for water management as a European Standard

(CEN) working in other sectors making a feasibility study.

At this workshop, **experts in the field of management wastewater treatment plants** and other related fields are invited to provide their points of view on the skills needed to work in the management of water resources, particularly in the management of **wastewater treatment plants**.
